Foundation Degree in Dementia Studies

This course is designed for health practitioners working in settings that provide dementia care. The course will enhance your professional practice so raising the care standards for dementia services.

Entry requirements

Applicants should have studied to a level 3 standard. All applicants will be interviewed. If you are a mature learner we are happy to discuss entry requirements on an individual basis taking into account prior learning and experience.

Course Length

The foundation degree will require 3 years of part time study.

How will I learn?

College attendance on taught sessions, tutorials, self directed private study and reflective accounts.

How will I be assessed?

Assessment is a continuous process throughout the programme. Each module will require completed work in a variety of forms; essay writing,

case studies, presentations, group debate and writing based on reflection of your professional practice.

There are no formal examinations.

Progression

The foundation degree will be awarded through the University of Bradford who have established Bachelor and Masters programmes in Dementia Studies as a progression opportunity.
